This matter was before the Court for a Status Conference on June 12, 2007, at 9:30 a.m. for Plaintiffs and Defendant Chesley and at 11:00 a.m. for Plaintiffs and Defendants Gallion, Mills and Cunningham. Counsel for the parties were present.


IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. The Court will review *in camera* documents provided by Defendant Chesley pursuant to the Plaintiffs' Motion for Compliance with the Court's Order of April 25, 2007.

2. Defendant Chesley's counsel shall e-mail the privilege log in question to Plaintiffs' counsel.
3. Defendant Chesley's counsel shall deliver to the Court's staff attorney the client file of Beverly Looney with an attached receipt to be delivered to Plaintiffs' counsel who will secure the signature of Ms. Looney.
4. The questions regarding Alma Ferguson will be addressed at the continued deposition of Defendant Chesley on June 15, 2007.
5. Defendants are granted until June 19, 2007, within which to file a response to Plaintiffs' Motions for Entry of Commissions to Depose Out of State Witnesses.
6. After an *in camera* review of the documents produced from the computers of Defendant Mills, the Court is of the opinion that those documents fall within attorney/client privilege and/or work product and not within any of the exceptions, and, therefore, not subject to discovery.
7. Counsel for Defendants Gallion and Cunningham provided information relative to the production of computers. Plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Production of Computers as to Chesley and the firm of Waite, Schneider, Bayless & Chesley shall remain under submission pending the deposition of Plaintiffs' expert.
8. All Motion for Sanctions shall remain under submission.
9. This matter shall be set for Status Conference on July 24, 2007, at 9:30 a.m.
10. **ALL** Motions noticed to be heard on July 24, 2007, shall be filed with the Court

on or before July 12, 2007; any Responses shall be filed with the Court on or before July 20, 2007. Counsel is reminded to provide the Special Judge with courtesy copies of all pleadings by e-mail to the Court's staff attorney or hand delivered to the Campbell County Courthouse.
